



2015 School Tax Credits Support Students

The Arizona State Public School Tax Credit Law allows taxpayers a Tax Credit of up to \$400 for those filing personal taxes as "married filing jointly" or \$200 for those filing "head of household" or "single" if they contribute to extracurricular activities. An extracurricular activity is an optional, non-credit educational or competitive activity that supplements the education program of the school and requires a fee for students to participate.
